# Rewa: Lt Governor's Students Support Initiative – Financial Assistance to meritorious students of Ladakh for availing coaching facility

#### What is the Scheme

The Administration of Union Territory of Ladakh shall give financial assistance for availing coaching facility for meritorious students.

A. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR COACHING FOR NATIONAL LEVEL ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS: Upto Rs 1 lakh shall be given as financial assistance to the meritorious students who plan to appear in the NEET, JEE, UG CLAT and NDA examinations to help them take up quality coaching. This shall include the following:

2	Reimbursement of Coaching fee (incl admission, tuition etc)	Upto Rs 64,000/-
	for day boarding institute/online/correspondence coaching

### A.1. For meritorious students of 10<sup>th</sup> Standard Board Examinations

30 students each belonging Kargil district and Leh district (total 60) will be selected on the basis of percentage /grade of marks secured in the  $10^{th}$  standard board examinations. The detailed breakup will be as given below:

### A.2. For meritorious students of 12<sup>th</sup> Standard Board Examinations

35 students belonging to Kargil district and Leh district (total 70) will be selected on the basis of percentage /grade of marks secured in the 12<sup>th</sup> Standard Board examinations. The number of students selected for each course will be as follows:

B. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR COACHING FOR NATIONAL LEVEL COMPETITIVE EXAMINATIONS: UptoRs 1.54 lakh shall be given as financial assistance to the students belonging to Ladakh who qualify the Prelim examination of Civil Services, Indian Forest Service and Indian Engineering Service, to help them take up quality coaching as follows:

2	Expenditure for boarding/lodging**(@Rs 3000, per month)	Upto Rs 54,000/-

# Who is Eligible

- 1. Students belonging to the Union Territory of Ladakh.
- 2. Students studying in the educational Institutions in the UT of Ladakh who are children of central government officials, All India Service officers, officials of PSUs and autonomous body of the central government, Public Sector Banks, officials of statutory bodies, shall also be eligible to avail the benefit.

# **How to Apply**

- 1. The Administration shall invite applications from eligible students soon after the results are declared for respective examinations.
- 2. Eligible candidates shall apply online with supporting documents and result sheet within the specified timelines.

- 3. **Merit list shall be prepared for the year** for each category based on the number of eligible applications.
- 4. The list shall be declared on the portal and selected students shall also receive a confirmation mail.
- 5. Approved candidates shall apply for reimbursement by submitting the fee receipt.
- 6. The admission to coaching institute may be undertaken within **two years** of the date of declaration of the merit list on the portal.
- 7. The fee receipt should also be submitted within **two years** of the date of declaration of the merit list on the portal for availing the scheme.
- 8. For the successful students of UPSC examination, coaching taken during the period 18 months before the date of preliminary examination and upto 18 months after preliminary examination shall be eligible for reimbursement.
- 9. The fee receipt should also be submitted within **two years** of the date of the respective preliminary examination for availing the scheme.

### How is financial assistance extended?

- 1. Approved candidates shall apply for reimbursement by submitting the fee receipt.
- 2. The admission to coaching institute may be undertaken within **two years** of the date of declaration of the merit list on the portal.
- 3. The fee receipt should also be submitted within **two years** of the date of declaration of the merit list on the portal for availing the scheme.
- 4. For the successful students of UPSC examination, coaching taken during the period 18 months before the date of preliminary examination and upto 18 months after preliminary examination shall be eligible for reimbursement.
- 5. The fee receipt should also be submitted within **two years** of the date of the respective preliminary examination for availing the scheme.
- 6. The concerned Departments will verify the credentials.
- 7. The amount shall be transferred directly to the beneficiary.

### Where can one take coaching to be eligible for reimbursement

In any registered coaching Institute in India. The Institute should have a website and GST No.

If the Institute is not a boarding Institute, do I need to provide proof of residence at place of coaching for availing the boarding/lodging allowance?

An undertaking is required by the candidate to this effect in the format given.

### If I take coaching online, will I be given boarding/lodging allowance?

A student can take online coaching at a place away from his/her place of permanent residence in Ladakh. In such situation, boarding/lodging allowance is permissible on production of an undertaking duly signed by the student.

How is selection done for meritorious students of Class X/XII

- 1. The Administration shall invite applications from eligible students soon after the results are declared for Class X, Class XII by respective boards.
- 2. Eligible candidates shall apply online with supporting documents and result sheet within the specified timelines.
- 3. There are three sub categories under Class X scheme. A separate merit list for each category shall be prepared for each district, however there shall be a common merit list across the Board.
- 4. Similarly there are three sub categories under Class XII scheme. A separate merit list for each category shall be prepared for each district, however there shall be a common merit list across the Board.
- 5. There merit list shall be prepared **for the year** based on the number of eligible applications. The list shall be declared on the portal.
- 6. Approved candidates shall apply for reimbursement by submitting the fee receipt.
- 7. The admission to coaching institute may be undertaken within **two years** of the date of declaration of the merit list on the portal.
- 8. The fee receipt should also be submitted within **two years** of the date of declaration of the merit list on the portal for availing the scheme.
- 9. The concerned Departments will verify the credentials.
- 10. The amount shall be transferred directly to the beneficiary.

### **How is selection done for Competitive Exams**

- 1. The Administration shall invite applications from eligible students soon after the results are declared for preliminary examination of Civil Services Examination, Engineering Services Examination or Indian Forest Service Examination
- 2. Eligible candidates shall apply online with supporting documents and result sheet within the specified timelines.
- 3. All those who have cleared the preliminary exams of the aforesaid Examinations qualify for the scheme.
- 4. They will get the confirmation from Department.
- 5. Approved candidates shall apply for reimbursement by submitting the fee receipt.
- 6. Coaching taken during the period **18 months before the date of preliminary examination and upto 18 months after preliminary examination** shall be eligible for reimbursement.
- 7. The fee receipt should be submitted within **two years** of the date of the respective preliminary examination.
- 8. The amount shall be transferred directly to the beneficiary.

### When can one apply
